

SUDSIES PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy describes our policies on the collection, use, and disclosure of your information in connection with your use of the Sudsies website at www.sudsies.com and other services we operate (collectively "Services"). The terms "SUDSIES®" "we", "us" and "our" refer to Sudsies, Inc. When you use the Services, you consent to our collection, use, and disclosure of your information as described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Categories of Personal Information We Collect

Personal information is information that directly identifies or can be used to identify you as an individual. When you visit or use our Services, we may collect your personal information as described below.

Information You Provide to Us

When you register to utilize certain portions of the Services, place an order, communicate with customer service or send us an email, you may be asked to provide, or you may choose to upload, certain information about yourself that we collect. Such information may include your first name, last name, email address, phone number, date of birth and credit card information.

Other Information We Receive and Store

We also receive information from you as a result of your visiting our Services and sending us emails, including your IP address, your email address, device identifiers, your browser type and version, your operating system and platform, your purchase history, products and services that you view, and other browser interaction information.

2. Use and Disclosure of Information We Collect

We will use and disclose your information only as follows:

- to provide the information and services you request from us and provide customer service;
- if, in the course of using our Services, you opt to receive occasional emails from us notifying you of special offers, we will use such information to notify you of such offers;
- if, in the course of using our Services, you opt to receive occasional emails from third parties to whom we provide your information, we will disclose such information to such third parties;

- to protect the rights and safety of us, our shareholders, members, officers, employees and customers;
- at our option, to notify you of any changes to this Privacy Policy or our other terms and conditions regarding these Services (you are bound by the terms of any changes we post online whether or not we notify you by email) and
- as otherwise required by law.

We may share your information with our family of companies, including subsidiaries and affiliates for business operations and to send you information about products or services that we think may be of interest to you.

We disclose your information to third parties only as reasonably required to fulfill your requests on our Services and collect sums due (such as to credit card processors), to protect the rights and safety of us, our shareholders, members, employees and customers (such as to legal representatives and law enforcement) as you expressly permit and as required by law (such as the result of a court subpoena). We may transfer your information in the event of the sale of substantially all of the assets of our business to a third party or in the event of a merger, consolidation or acquisition. However, in such event, any acquirer will be subject to the provisions of our commitments to you.

[We do not sell your personal information to any third party in exchange for monetary consideration.]

3. Cookies and Similar Technologies

Cookies are small text files that are stored on browsers or devices by websites, apps, online media, and advertisements that are used to remember your browser or device during and across visits. We may use and place cookies (and web beacons, mobile device identifiers and other similar technologies) on your device to collect information about the use of our website, customize your visit to the Services and for other purposes to make your visit more convenient or to enable us to enhance our Services. [In addition, third party advertisers that appear on our Services may also place cookies on your device and use similar anonymous tracking technologies.] You may stop or restrict the placement of cookies on your device, in which case you may still use our Services, but it may interfere with the functionality of some features.

4. Security Practices

The security of your information is very important to us. We have put in place reasonable physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard the information we collect. However, due to the inherent open nature of the internet, we cannot guarantee that communications between you and us or information stored on the Services or our servers

will be completely free from unauthorized access by third parties such as hackers, and your use of the Services demonstrates your assumption of this risk.

5. No Users Under Age 18

We do not knowingly collect personal information from people under the age of eighteen (18). When we become aware that personal information from a person under 18 has been collected, we will use all reasonable efforts to delete such information from our database.

6. Changes to Privacy Policy

We reserve the right, at our discretion, to change, modify, add, or remove portions from this policy at any time. Any changes in our Privacy Policy will be posted on our Services and will become effective as of the date of posting with respect to information we then collect in the future, but our policy will not be changed with respect to information that we have then already collected. It is and will be your responsibility to review our Privacy Policy from time to time to make sure you are aware of any changes. Your continued use of the Services following the posting of any changes to this policy means you accept such changes.

7. Opt-Out Process

We give you the option to remove your information from our list of active users completely.

If you do not wish us to share your information with third parties who may use such information for direct marketing purposes, you may send an email to us at info@sudsies.com.

If you wish to have us remove your information permanently from our list of active users, you may send an email to us at info@sudsies.com. However, if you make such a request, you will no longer be able to use the Services unless you register again as if you were a new user.

Although we will process your opt-out requests within a reasonable period of time, we are not responsible for removing your information from the lists of any third party who has previously been provided your information in accordance with this policy.

8. Conditions of Use, Notices, and Revisions
